Southwestern Academic Research Centre High School Research Opportunities Program (SWARC HROP)

The SWARC HROP is a one-of-a-kind program unique to SWSC that invites enthusiastic students to participate in a wide range of research activities across various interdisciplinary fields in collaboration with SWSC's faculty members, alumni, external mentors or partnering organizations. It is the first of its kind in Nepal. As SWSC aims to promote the culture of research among its students, HROP stands as the beating heart of SWSC's steps towards the future. As SWARC HROP fellow, students will be involved in undertaking research in the topics of their interest promoting themselves in in-depth learning, co-working skills, research skills, laboratory techniques, and many more skills needed for a future researcher. With SWARC HROP, students get to apply the things that they have learned in class in real-life situations solving important issues and problems along the way.

The SWARC HROP consists of two routes:

Predefined Topics: These are research topics already set in collaboration with the faculty, alumni, mentors, external mentors or partnering organizations. Mentors will select and set the teams in the research groups after evaluating all applications and resources.

Research Proposal: The research proposal program is a year-long program that invites students to bring in personal research proposals of their individual interests. If an application is accepted after proper review, a mentor is assigned or looked for, and then students can research in their individual field of interest. With coordination of the SWARC HROP coordinator, the student can also open applications for co-working members for the research project.

Entrepreneurial Skills

At Southwestern State College, we encourage our students to become job creators rather than job seekers by enhancing their creative and innovative entrepreneurial skills. We provide comprehensive knowledge regarding critical life skills to our students such as problem solving, brainstorming ideas, setting goals, taking risks, facing failure and getting up again by involving them in various group projects, individual projects, case studies, and group discussions.

Bachelor in Computer Application (BCA)

Bachelor in Computer Application (BCA) is a four-year (eight semesters) program affiliated to Tribhuvan University. The course is principally designed to cover essential computer related topics such as networking, programming, software development and information systems. In addition, the students study various courses linked with information technology such as System Analysis and Design, Network Programming, Digital Logic, Distributed System and Computer Networking. Studying these areas will equip students with the necessary skills of the technical field before moving into any area of management and organization. Bachelor of Social Work (BSW)

Bachelor of Social Work is a four-year course affiliated to Tribhuvan University. This degree provides students with the knowledge and skills required for a professional career as a social worker.
